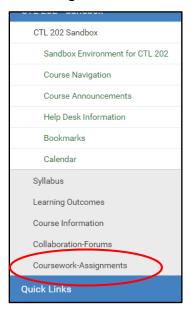

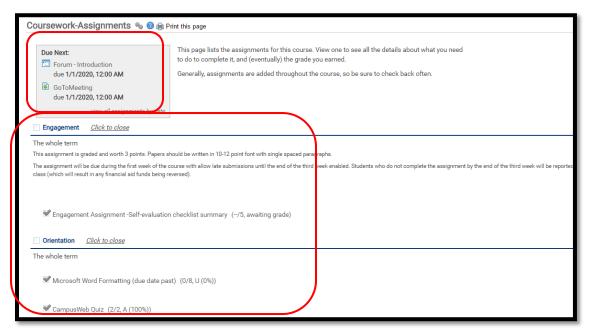

Basic Format	

To access your assignments, navigate to the desired course, and select Coursework-Assignments from the left menu.



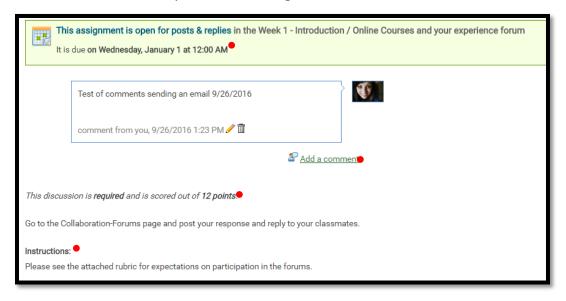

All assignments will be listed in the Coursework-Assignments area of the Main Course Menu. This area has two-divisions: an area for Due Next (assignments where the due date is near) and a list of all assignments; past, current, and future.



Click an assignment's name to display:

- Due date
- Comments
- If required or optional and points/percentage available for the assignment
- Instruction/description for the assignment

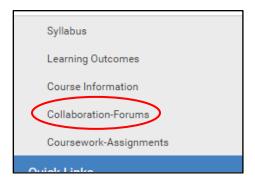


While there are similarities amongst assignments, please note there are differences in assignment type as shown below.

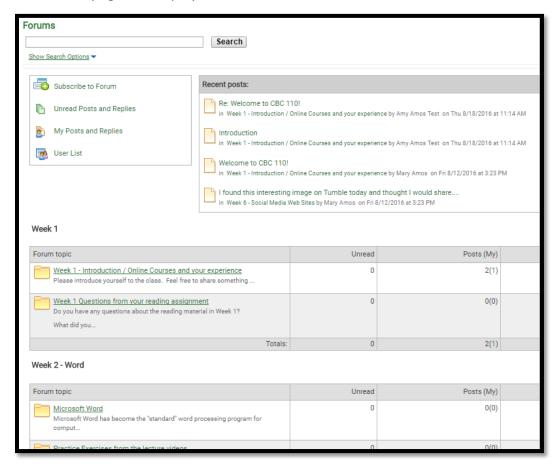
Forums/Discussion

Follow these steps to successfully post in a Forum:

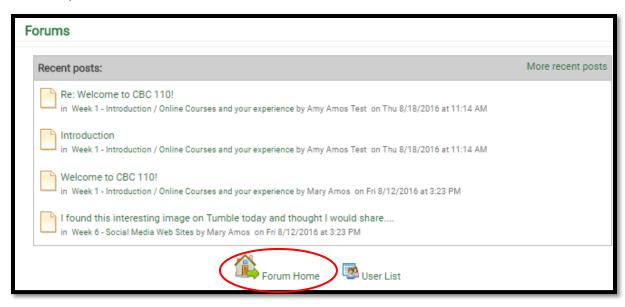
1. Click Collaboration-Forums from the Course left menu.



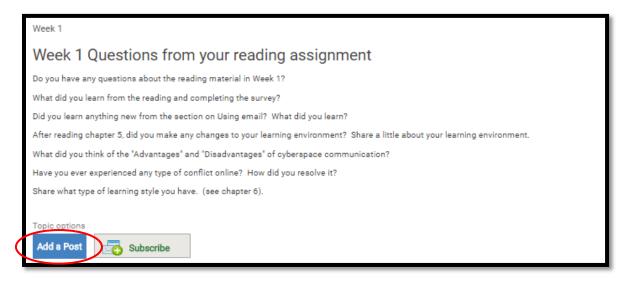
The Forums page will display.



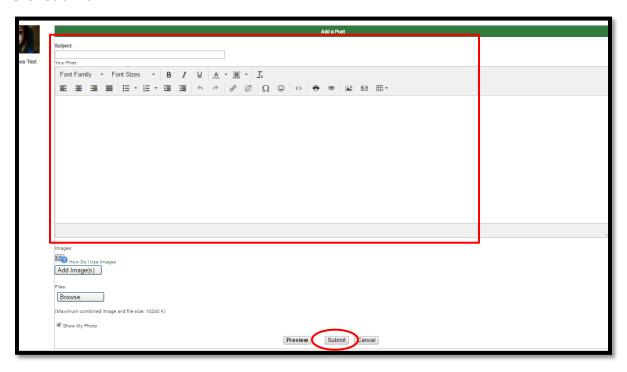
• If you do not see the above screen, click Forum Home.

- 5. Click Submit.



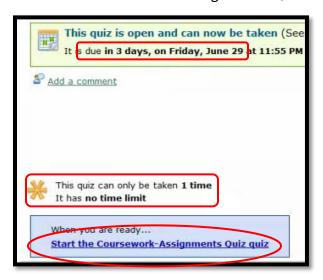
 When a post is submitted, the Reply option becomes available in the top right corner of the forum window.



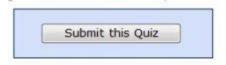
Test/Quiz

Follow these steps to submit an online Test or Quiz:

 - Details such due date, number of attempts, and time limit will display.
- 2. Click Start the Coursework-Assignments Quiz



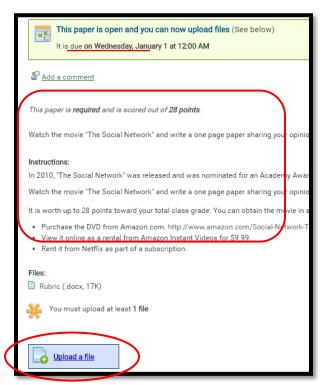
- Answer the questions to the best of your ability.
- 3. Click Submit this Test/Quiz when complete and ready to be graded.



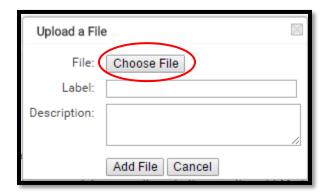
File Upload/Papers

A file upload or paper requires you to browse your computer to upload the document and submit the assignment.

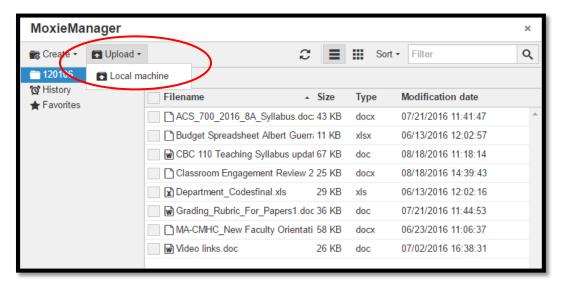
- 1. Click on the name of the assignment.
- 2. Click Upload a file.



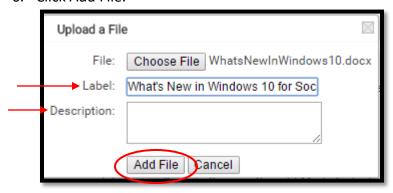
3. Click Choose File.



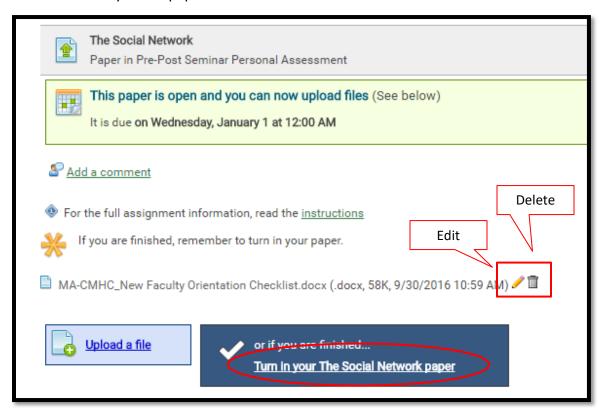
- MoxieManager window will open.
- 4. Click Upload, Local machine.



- 5. Browse your computer to locate the file and upload the attachment.
 - Add a label/description if desired.
- 6. Click Add File.



- The following will display.
 - o Click Edit to make changes to the attachment before submitting.
 - o Click Delete to remove the attachment.
- 7. Click Turn in your XX paper to finalize the submission.



Basic Format

Basic format indicates that information regarding the assignment will be listed under Coursework-Assignments but the actual work will be completed elsewhere. For example, the assignment could be to watch a previously recorded lecture – the information regarding the lecture will be in Coursework-Assignments, directing you to where the lecture is housed.
